Three IP scenarios
to understand:

1. WHAT YOU PUT IN



If you input copyrighted work
(another school's policy,
textbook extracts) → **You may be
infringing copyright**



2. WHAT AI PUTS OUT

AI may have been trained
on copyrighted material
without permission
→ Outputs might include
protected elements



3. SECONDARY INFRINGEMENT

If you publish AI outputs that
contain unlicensed material
→ You could be liable



WHO OWNS WHAT?

- Student work = student/parent owns copyright
- Teacher-created materials = teacher owns copyright
- Need permission to use in AI training
